Somewhere in Turkey, a few hours away from Ankara, a blacksmith lives happily with his beautiful wife and his three daughters, Gül, Melike, and Sibel. When their mother suddenly dies Gül takes care of her younger sisters. Burdened with worrying about her family she drops out of school and starts to work as a tailor's hand. patriarchal society of their parents and grandparents - one is going to be a teacher, the other marries a husband she really loves - Gül is deprived of such a chance. Instead she is pressured into a marriage with Fuat, a drunkard who is dreaming of a better life in Western Europe. Fuat finally leaves Turkey and goes to Germany like many of his fellow countrymen. Gül follows him a little later with her two children and a little cardboard suitcase in hand but she doesn't like Germany and doesn't speak the language. By telling Gül's story Selim Özdogan evokes the sheltered yet constricted life in a small Turkish town whose balance is subtly disturbed by the yearning for a different and better life.

Selim Özdogan, born in 1971, lives in Cologne as a freelance author. Previously published by the same author: «Es ist so einsam im Sattel, seit das Pferd tot ist»; «Nirgendwo und Hormone»; «Mehr»; «Ein Spiel, das die Götter sich leisten» (Rights sold to: Turkey).

Hansjörg Schertenleib: The Lucky One

A friend invites an exceptionally gifted Swiss trumpeter named This Studer to fill in his jazz combo for a few gigs in Amsterdam. Studer wants to assure himself that his wife still loves him and together they drift through the colourful world of canals in Amsterdam for a weekend. He shows her the side roads and silent places of his Amsterdam. Then, one evening, Studer meets a dog at one of the canals and is

reminded of something that had happened in his youth near Zurich where his grandfather introduced him to Jazz music. Studer runs across the dog several times during the next few days and it almost seems that the dog is pursuing him. For one moment his almost proverbial luck leaves him and he has the feeling that he needs to settle an old debt. By evoking the captivating atmosphere of Amsterdam and depicting the vivid images of a childhood in Switzerland, Schertenleib accomplishes a beautiful novella about music, the undistinguishable traces of memories and the different aspects of luck.

Hansjörg Schertenleib, born in Zurich in 1957 has published numerous novels, short stories, poems, plays and screenplays. He lives in Ireland. At night the families meet in the bar and talk about the vipers and about a local murder. What looked like an accident now seems to be a well-planned act of revenge. The father of the victim, Carlo, has delayed the funeral

Herrmann Kant: Cinema

An old man is sitting in his sleeping bag on a wet boulevard one rainy day in October. He explains to the passers-by his performance is an art form. His place is well-chosen for a "study of sense" and in order to avoid misunderstandings he has placed a little card in front of him saying ,,do not disturb and no donations, please". Stimulated by his observations he entertains himself and his chance acquaintances with his

newest impressions of the world and memories from his childhood in Hamburg. But in spite of his inconspicuous post he is in the way when an Asian billionaire visits the scene and causes organizational and diplomatic turmoil. Suddenly the observer is irritated by appearance and reality.

Hermann Kant was born in Hamburg in 1926. After training to be an electrician, he joined the German army, and from 1945 to 1949 was a prisoner-of-war in Poland. He was a co-founder of an antifascist committee in a Polish labor camp. After 1949 he returned to university and later worked as a researcher and editor. From 1978 to 1990 he was president of the East German writers' association. Today he lives in Mecklenburg. By accident Eli survived the bombing of Dresden on February 13th, 1945 but she lost both of her parents and is now growing up at her grandfather's. Eli believes herself to be superior to everyone because of the miracle of her survival. She trains to be invisible by always living correctly, always being on time and giving no cause for any requests. While the people of Dresden are ready to suppress the

horrors of the bombing Eli moves around in the city like a shadow. She is allowed to bring food to the gardeners, deliver plants to decorate the festival halls and bring flowers to the monuments. Unrecognised and unnoticed she walks across the city with her little wagon and a burning soul. In her heart is a great yearning to be important, to rescue and help people, especially the two men she is in love with.

Helga Schütz, born in Falkenhein, Silesia, has been working as a freelance author since 1962 and worked as a professor at the University for Film and TV in Potsdam. Tanja Dückers, Verena Carl (eds.): City, Country, War

The Nazi regime perished 60 years ago but it has not become history. The children of the generation of the culprits have critically scrutinized the doings and failures of their parents for decades, but the manifold consequences of the Third Reich are still of great concern to the grandchildren. This anthology shows how the generation of these grandchildren has also intensively dealt with its family's past but in a very different way than their parents have.

Armin Mueller-Stahl: Hannah

After the death of his daughter Hannah the successful writer Hermann meets with his childhood friend Arnold in the suite of a luxury hotel. For Hermann their conversation turns into a confession at the end of which he discovers a secret that has overshadowed both of his and Arnold's lives. But it is also a requiem for Hannah who learned how to play the violin at the age of four and became a violinist of great

virtuosity. She was the center of Hermann's life; he admired her, looked after her. But Hannah had no clue that Hermann was not her real father. When she found out the truth she fled, completely taken aback, and was tragically killed in an accident. In their grief for Hannah, Arnold and Hermann take comfort in each other and find new support.

Born in 1930, **Armin Mueller-Stahl** was a noted concert violinist while still in his teens. Mueller-Stahl turned to film acting in East Berlin in 1950. Mueller-Stahl became a persona non grata with the communist regime in 1977, due to his activism in protesting government suppression of performing artists. He relocated to the West in 1980, where he recouped his film stardom in productions of Fassbinder and Agnieszka Holland. He then gained international recognition in Costa-Gavra's The Music Box (1989), Barry Levinson's Avalon (1990) and, above all, for his portrayal of pianist David Helfgott's domineering father in Scott Hicks' Shine for which he received a Best Supporting Actor Oscar nomination. Mueller-Stahl who has published several best-selling books in Germany now also excels as a novelist.

Robert Schneider: Christ

When eight-year-old Jan Beukels is asked to write down what he is going to be when he grows up, he scribbles down «Christ». What his teacher takes as blasphemy derives from a naive wish. A few days earlier Jan had watched an Easter procession which reenacted Jesus' entering Jerusalem on a mule on Palm Sunday. Jan had decided then that he wanted to be just as worshipped and acclaimed as Christ and he looked ever since then for a mission to help him accomplish this goal. Only 17 years later he has indeed succeeded in becoming the prophetic king of the huge community of Anabaptists residing in the German town of Münster. God on earth ends in a terrible disaster when the town is besieged and Jan turns into a cruel despot. Robert Schneider, the author of the world-best-seller «Schlafes Bruder», brings to life the adventurousness, the gloominess, and the eccentricity of the 16th century and its people. He brilliantly illustrates how the Anabaptists quest for paradise brought about a living hell and, in addition, has achieved a novel of burning topicality.

Robert Schneider was born in Bregenz, Austria in 1961. He grew up in a mountain village in the Alps in the upper valley of the Rhine, where he lives today as a freelance author. Schneider studied composition, history of art, and theater studies in Vienna. His first novel, *«Schlafes Bruder»* (*«Brother of Sleep»*) was published in 1992 and immediately became a sensational literary success and has been translated into 32 languages. Schneider has received numerous awards including the Premio Grinzane Cavour, the Prix Médicis among many others. *«Kristus»* is his fifth novel.

Titus Müller: The Spectacle Maker

In 1387 only a few masters are in command of the art of spectacle making, the difficult task of grinding the lenses and carving fine wooden frames. Courtenay, archbishop of Canterbury, knows the importance of this trade. Being masters of sight and therefore of scripture the spectacle makers might have power where swords would fail. In order to crush a secret society Courtenay wants to take advantages

of the skill of Elias Rowe, one of the best spectacle makers. However, Elias is not willing to support his cause and his young wife Catherine finds him dead one morning in his workshop. The young widow wanting to find his murderers learns his trade and gets right into the middle of the power struggle between the archbishop and the secret society.

Twelve-year-old Ma Li and her sister Lingling live with relatives in China in 1919. They have never met their father, and when their mother dies of hunger Ma Li has to toil in the inn of her uncle until a dubious alleged rescuer shows up and takes both sisters to Shanghai. But the man proves to be a white slaver. He wants to sell beautiful Ma Li to a bordello and the dwarf Lingling to a circus. But Madame Lin, who

owns several bars and bordellos, saves the girls. Madame Lin sees in Ma Li not only the daughter she had never had but also her chance to rise to a higher position in Shanghai's society. In her lonely hours Ma Li dreams of a Jade palace, the place of eternal beauty that her mother once told her about. She swears that one day she will live with her sister in such a palace. Courageously she plans her rise and takes her destiny into her own hands.

Raymond A. Scofield is the pseudonym for Gert Anhalt and is a correspondent in Japan for German public TV. He studied Asiatic languages and history and has lived many years in China. He also published: «Die Tibet-Verschwörung»; «Die Krallen des Tigers».

Guido Dieckmann: The Night of the Stone Rider

Cathedrals are believed to be the most magnificent gates to heaven in the imperial Franconian town of Bamberg during the 13th century. Therefore young Lukas wants to assists the greatest European architects and craftsmen with the completion of the mighty cathedral. With a forged diploma he manages to get himself employed as a stonemason. But when his secret is in danger of being discovered he escapes to a castle nearby. Its mysterious landlady assigns Lukas Guido Dieckmann Die Nacht des steinernen Reiters The Night of the Stone Rider Aufbau Taschenbuch Verlag, 2005 approx. 400 pp.

to create an equestrian statue for the cathedral. With great zeal he begins his work until someone attempts to take his life. The Rider of Bamberg is said to be one of the most enigmatic artworks of the world.

Guido Dieckmann, born in 1969, studied History and lives as freelance author in Haßloch/ Pfalz. Within only a few years he has made himself a name as an author for successful historical novels. Wladimir Gelfand: German Diary 1945 – 1946

The Second World War rapidly changes Wladimir Gelfand's course of life. After serving at the front, Gelfand, a young Ukrainian Jew, witnesses destruction and death, experiences comradeship and treachery and discovers foreign places in occupied Germany. In his diaries form the years 1945 to 1946 Gelfand writes of his relentless grapple with the hated military. He describes the fights, the politics and the every-day-life of occupation. He goes to the tailor, buys at the black market, visits pubs, learns how to take photographs and makes his own peculiar experiences with women. He is a sensitive observer and accomplice in one and he does not attempt to conceal his acts of revenge and looting. Gelfand's diaries are a unique chronicle of the early Soviet occupation of Germany.

Pierre Radvanyi: Beyond the Stream

Anna Seghers, one of the great German novelists of the 20th century has never talked much about her private every-daylife. Now, her son Pierre who was very close to his mother recollects the life they shared. Pierre Radvany was seven when his parents fled to France and fifteen when they immigrated to Mexico. He describes Anna Seghers as a caring tender mother, tells about her writing habits and her worldwide circle of friends, among them Brecht, Helene Weigel, Kisch, Jorge Amado, and Pablo Neruda. During the interment of his father, Pierre became his mother's adviser and assistant. In 1945 he returned to France where he still lives today. mother and son was continued through letters and visits. She confided in him the problems in the German Democratic Republic, he became witness to her reaction to the Stalinist crimes and the expatriation of critical writers. Beyond the Stream is a very personal view on a great author.

Pierre Radvanyi was born in 1926 in Berlin. He studied physics in Paris and is known for his extensive research projects and publications on radioactivity, nuclear reactions and the production of elementary particles. He lives near Paris and works as a research director emeritus of the CNRS.

Heiko Engelkes: King Jacques

Jacques Chirac is one of the most dazzling figures in European politics, and like no one else represents the self-understanding of «La Grande Nation». Power-loving, charming, shrewd in dealing with the media, and immune to the financial and erotic affairs which are accredited to him, he stages himself at times in the manner of the «Sun King», Ludwig the XIV. Like the «Sun King», Chirac created a network of abiders in the Elysee palace, among them his wife Bernadette and his daughter Claude. Heiko Engelkes,

who was a German public TV correspondent of many years in Paris, critically examines the myth of «King Jacques» and depicts a multi-faceted portrait of the charismatic statesmen giving insight both into the history of France as well as the current events.

Heiko Engelkes, born in 1933, lives in Paris. In 1999 he received the Andenauer-de-Gaulle Award. Among his previous publications are «Bonjour Paris - Mein Leben mit Frankreich»; «Mitterand, aus der Nähe gesehen».

Richard Andrews: Aaron's Vision

The life of Jewish scientist and spy Aaron Aaronsohn is an adventurous family saga and, at the same time, a visionary history about the Near East and the First World War. Side by side with Lawrence of Arabia Aaronsohn worked for the British intelligence service. The information smuggled out of Palestine by his spy ring contributed greatly to the success of the Allies in the Near East. However, his goals for an Israeli state within moderate borders could not be accomplished: on the way to the decisive peace talks in Versailles in 1919 Aaronsohn's airplane mysteriously vanished - a tragedy whose consequences can still be felt today. Richard Andrews lays open a whole panorama of major players in the Near East during the First World War **Richard Andrews** Lawrence of Arabia's Master Spy 38 photographs

and sheds new light on the British policy in the region. By looking closely at Aaronsohn's great foresight and drawing on a wide array of archival resources previously unknown, Andrews brilliantly identifies the major historical roots for today's conflict between Israelis and Palestinians. Aaron's Vision thus emerges as a compelling book of permanent value for the ongoing quest for peace in the Near East.

Richard Andrews, is an archaeologist and historical author with extensive experience of Europe and the Middle East. During the Yom Kippur War of 1973 he served as a volunteer for Israel on the Lebanese border. In 1975 he worked as a civilian mine clearance diver and liaison officer to the Egyptian government in the Suez Canal Zone. Egmont Koch: Nuclear Weapons for Al-Qaida

Far-reaching insights about the danger of terrorism by Islamic fundamentalists have constantly captivated politics, the media and secret services. With his portrait of Abdul Qadeer Khan, father of the Pakistani nuclear bomb, journalist and author Egmont R. Koch reveals disconcerting dimensions of this current threat. stole blueprints for nuclear power plants. With the help of his German friends he built up a network that supplied him with the newest technology. By Kahn's knowledge Pakistan rose to a nuclear power within 10 years and in the 1990s Kahn sold his know-how also to Libya, North-Korea, and Iran. States such as Saudi-Arabia, Syria, Taiwan, and Al Qaida are suspected of having taken his offer. In October 1998 Koch exclusively interviewed Khan in Islamabad and for the first time Khan recounted how he was able to build the bomb and outsmart authorities and the CIA. The main source of information Koch draws on is Richard M. Barlow, former intelligence analyst for the CIA. Koch impressively analyzes the history of the «Islamic Bomb» and its secret support from Germany and the dangers of new assault by Al-Qaida against their main enemies: the U.S. and Britain.

Egmont Koch, born in 1945, excelled in 1975 with his bestseller «Seveso ist überall». He has researched the Third World's nuclear armament for 20 years. He has produced awardwinning documentaries for German public TV and his books have been translated in 12 languages. Günter Gödde: Mathilde Freud

Mathilde Freud (1887-1978) wrote about 60 letters to a doctor's son from Munich named Eugen Pachmayer. These letters are not only of interest for research on Freud but also give insight into the world of a young girl of the Jewish Bourgeoisie at the beginning of the 20th century. Mathilde being sometimes playful and flirtatious and sometimes critical and provoking considers marrying Eugen however he decides for another woman. Shortly thereafter Mathilde marries Robert Hollitscher who is twelve years older than her. Always close to her parents, her further path of life leads her through several illnesses, blows of fate and economic crisis until she finally achieves

professional autonomy. 1933 she leaves Vienna for London where she worked as a fashion designer and ran the fashion store "Robell".

Günter Gödde, born in 1946, works as a psychologist, psychotherapist, teacher and supervisor. His main fields of research are Freud's biography and the History of Psychoanalysis. He lives in Berlin.

Anna Freud Bernays: A Viennese in New York.

Two years younger than Sigmund, Anna tells of her childhood and youth in imperial Vienna and her life in the New World, where she spent sixty years. It is the story of a lively woman between Europe and America, a document that has only been know before to the Freud family and selected Freud specialists. Ann Freud Bernays was born in 1858 and married Eli Bernays, the brother of Sigmund Freud's wife Martha. By immigrating to the United States in 1892 she was spared from the fate of their four sisters who were murdered in the concentration camps during 1942/43.

Walter Schulze / Rolf Schneider: Home Coming Into Life

Rarely has every-day-life in Berlin been depicted so authentically or its motives so humanly. After the war Berlin was a city torn between apathy and being on the move. Slowly life returned to the debris and the ruins. Walter Schulze captured with his camera what was happening on the streets: homecomings, old ladies in the soup kitchen, street musicians, children playing, and dealers on the black market. The images from the years 1945/1946 until 1960 are supplemented by the texts of Rolf Schneider. Walter Schulze, (1910-1963) worked as a press photographer for several newspapers and lived in Berlin. Not much else is know about his life, a Berlin gallery owner recently discovered his photographs after the dissolving of a household.

Rolf Schneider, born in 1932, published novels, theatre plays, essays and non-fiction books. He has worked for several daily and weekly newspapers.

Astrid Proll: Pictures on the Run

The German terrorist group Red Army Fraction (RAF) left a deep mark on German history and society. The RAF also left a history of photographs behind that have long entered the collective memory of the Germans. Renowned artists such as Gerhard Richter referred to these photographs in their work. Many of the photographs in this book can be found on T-shirts and record covers. Today, the RAF has become "cult". The political revolt against the establishment has become a base of aestheticism that reminds us of the oppressive atmosphere of that time.

Astrid Proll, born in 1947, came to the RAF at the end of the 1960s and was imprisoned from 1971-1974. She went underground in England and was turned over to Germany in 1978. Shortly thereafter she was acquitted. She worked as a photographic editor for «Der Spiegel», «Time Magazine», and «The Independent». Since 2003 she has been living in Berlin where she teaches Art and Photography.

Holger Teschke: Rügen

Rügen is a popular island that has retained its magic throughout the millennia. Freebooter Klaus Störtebeker hid his treasures in the island's bays, Caspar David Friedrich created the famous painting of Rügen, Theodor Fontane let Effi Briest stroll on the beach of Saßnitz, Bismarck wrote the draft to the first German constitution in Putbus and Lenin noted down his April Theses. Samuel Beckett dreamt of the Baltic Sea and Günter Grass let his rat make mischief in the waters of Rügen.
